I. Purpose

The purposes of this policy are to establish Board goals and objectives relating to energy conservation and environmental stewardship; to facilitate responsible conservation practices; to emphasize environmental education; to allow Harford County Public Schools (HCPS) to comply with current and future regulations relating to energy management and conservation; to establish practices that will be applied to all aspects of HCPS operation to include but not limited to Operations and Facilities Management, Transportation, Planning and Construction, Procurement, and school-based decisions.

II. Statement of Policy

- A. It is the policy of the Board that HCPS shall conduct its business and operations to the extent reasonable and practical, so as to:
 - 1. Utilize the minimum amount of energy.
 - 2. Explore and implement energy conservation programs.
 - **3.** Explore and utilize efficient procurement strategies to secure services required to implement planned energy conservation programs.
 - 4. Utilize technology to monitor and develop energy usage reports concerning but not limited to:
 - a. The amount of electricity used from renewable energy sources; and
 - b. The overall electricity use by source and square foot; and
 - c. Current and historical data of energy use by square foot.
 - 5. Explore the use of renewable energy sources in both new and existing facilities.
 - 6. Utilize alternative funding approaches to leverage implementation of renewable energy, conservation, recycling projects through partnerships with private organizations and other creative funding strategies.
 - 7. Partner with other government institutions in energy and environmental stewardship programs.
 - 8. Educate all stakeholders in best practices around energy conservation and environmental stewardship.

B. The Superintendent will consult with the Energy Management Committee to develop, review, and implement procedures and policy.
