DECISION ON CONTRACT AWARD FOR BUS SECURITY CAMERAS

July 15, 2019

Background Information:

On behalf of the Transportation Department, the Purchasing Department is requesting approval to piggyback a contract with IVS, Inc., dba AngelTrax located at 119 South Woodburn Drive, Dothan, AL 26305.

The basis for the cost of these services is via piggybacking a competitively bid contract established by the PEPPM 2019 Technology Cooperative Purchasing Program—Product Line Bid, contract number #528897. The contract term is effective January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2021, unless terminated, cancelled or extended.

The total annual expenditure is expected to be in excess of \$100,000. The contracts will be utilized on an as-needed basis. For any single purchase exceeding \$100,000, board approval will be requested.

Discussion:

The contract with AngelTrax provides for a wide-range of customizable solutions for bus surveillance and reliable monitoring solutions. These security solutions will be included on any new buses purchased for the 2019-2020 school year, to ensure the safety and security of our students.

The funding source for these services are Safety and Security and various Transportation Operating accounts.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education accept the recommendation made by the Purchasing Department and award the contract to IVS, Inc. dba AngelTrax of Dothan, AL., from the date of contract award and ending on December 31, 2021.
