**DECISION ON CONTRACT AWARD FOR BUS CAMERA AND HARD DRIVE
SYSTEMS**

JUNE 8, 2020

Background Information:

On behalf of the Transportation Department, the Purchasing Department is requesting approval to award a contract to IVS, Inc., doing business as AngelTrax, located at 119 South Woodburn Drive, Dothan, Alabama 36305 for the purchase, delivery and installation of bus camera and hard drive systems, in the amount of \$420,041.14.

Discussion:

Since 2011, Angel Trax has been providing mobile video surveillance systems for HCPS school buses. This contract will cover the purchase, delivery and installation of thirty-nine (39) hard drives and video surveillance systems for one hundred seventy-three (173) school buses.

The contracting vehicle for this procurement is through the Pennsylvania Education Purchasing Program for Microcomputers (PEPPM). The Central Susquehanna Intermediate Unit, IU #16 competitively bid these products and services under the PEPPM 2019 Product Line Bid, Contract #528897-017.

The funding sources for this purchase are the FY20 Transportation Special Education Transportation Other Equipment Operating Budget in the amount of \$108,679.54 and Safe Schools Fund Grant Accounts in the amount of \$311,361.60.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education approve the award of a contract to IVS, Inc., doing business as AngelTrax, in the amount of \$402,041.14.

The current PEPPM contract is valid through December 31, 2021.
