**DECISION ON CONTRACT AWARD FOR STORM POND REPAIR AT
ABERDEEN HIGH SCHOOL**

Background Information:

On behalf of the Facilities Department, the Purchasing Department is requesting approval to award a contract to Ecotone, Inc., located at 129 Industry Lane, Forest Hill, MD 21050 for repairs to the storm pond at Aberdeen High School, in the amount of \$159,802.18.

Discussion:

Harford County Public Schools is responsible for maintaining storm water management facilities located on various school grounds throughout Harford County. The storm pond at Aberdeen High School is not functioning as designed. The pond has been cited by the City of Aberdeen for non-compliance. The work to be completed from this contract will remedy the issues and will make the pond compliant.

The contracting vehicle for this project is HCPS Bid #14-JHC-026.

The funding sources for this purchase are the FY20 Facilities Operating Budget.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education approve the award of a contract to Ecotone, Inc., in the amount of \$159,802.18.
