**INFORMATIONAL REPORT**

**DECISION ON CONTRACT AWARD FOR THE REMOVAL OF HAZARDOUS  
MATERIAL AT JOPPATOWNE HIGH SCHOOL**

**DECEMBER 6, 2021**

Background Information:

On behalf of the Facilities Department, the Procurement Department is requesting approval to award a contract to A & I, Inc. located at 8902 Yellow Brick Road, Rosedale, MD 21237 for the removal of hazardous material at Joppatowne High School, in the amount of \$105,136.

Discussion:

The limited renovation construction project at Joppatowne High School includes asbestos abatement. The original contract was for \$640,698.38. During remediation, a tunnel in the air handler room containing a duct with asbestos was discovered which needs to be removed and disposed of, in the amount of \$39,264. In addition, work that was originally scheduled during the Summer of 2021 was not able to be performed while school was not in session. Therefore, additional coverage is needed to complete the remediation during off-hours to accommodate Joppatowne High School's administration and students, in the amount of \$65,872. The total additional amount for this project is \$105,136.

The contracting vehicle for this project is HCPS Bid #20-JHS-016, On-Call Hazardous Materials Removal and Services.

The funding source for this purchase is the Joppatowne High School Limited Renovation – Capital Budget.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education approve the award of the contract to A & I, Inc., in the amount of \$105,136.

This contract is effective through October 31, 2022, with the option to renew for an additional three (3) years.
