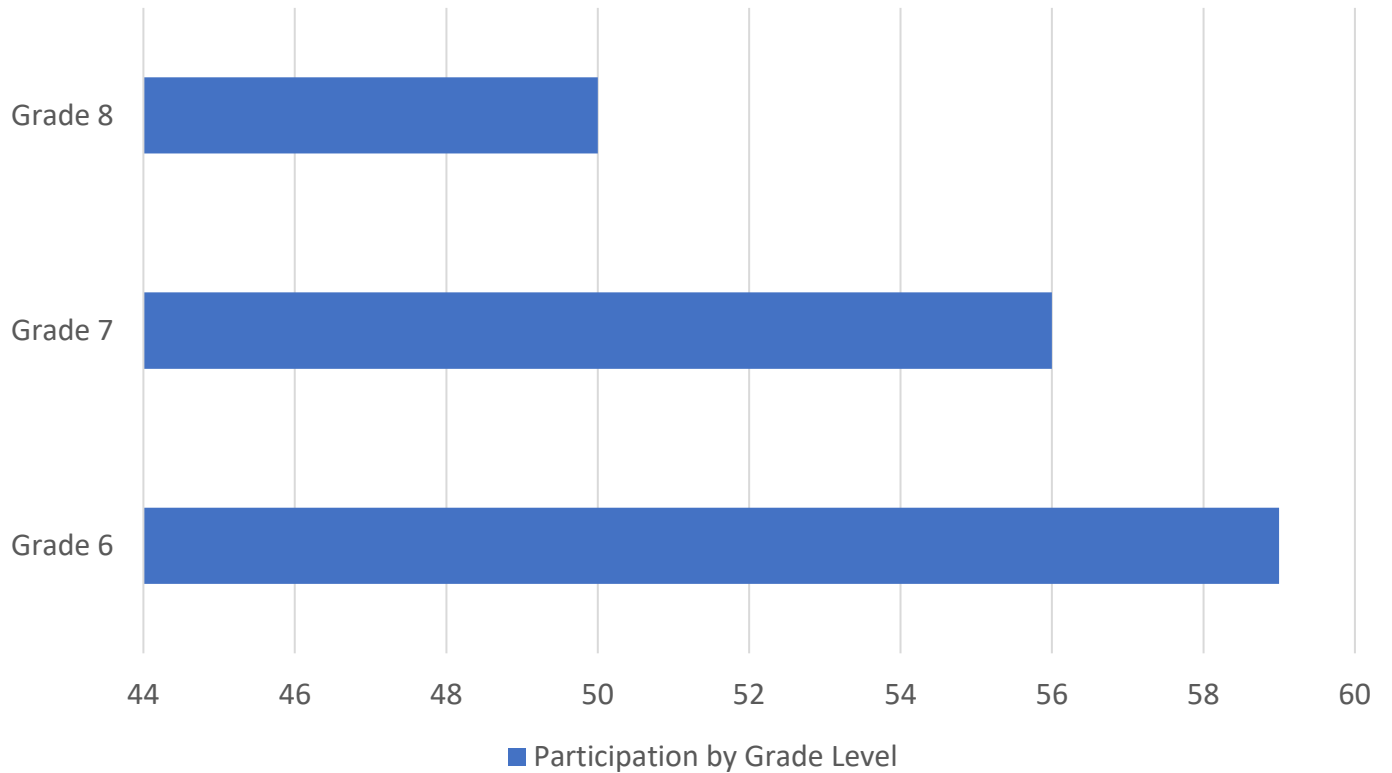
# Middle School Overview



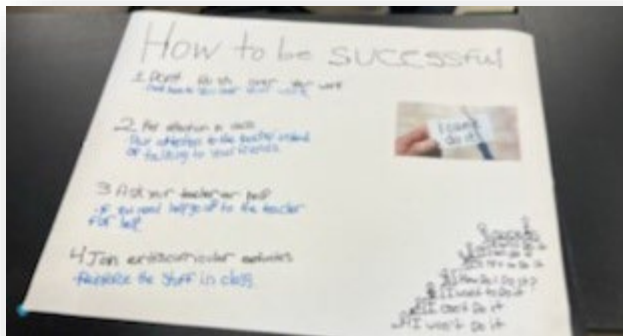

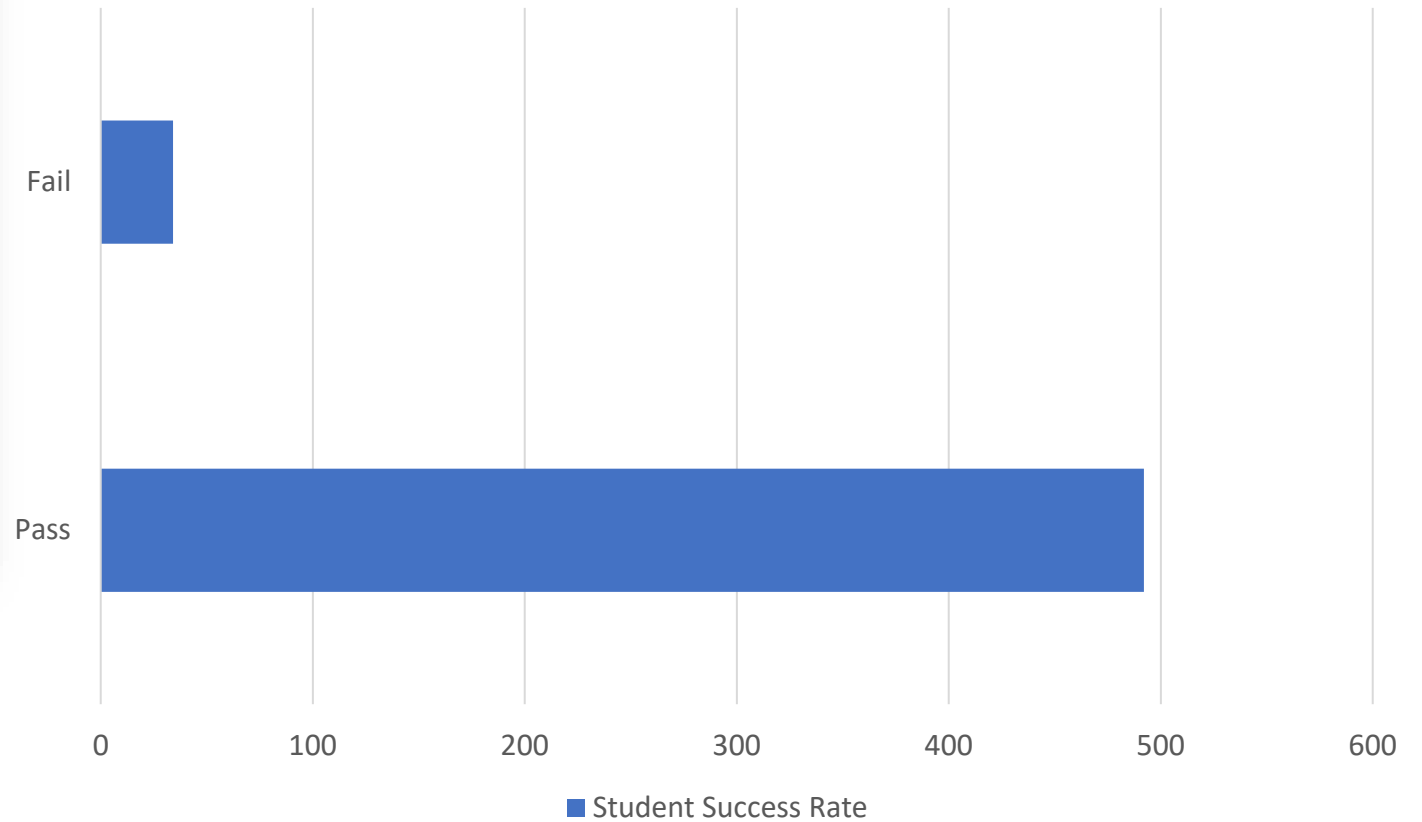
