





What is National Board Certification?

PURPOSE

- National Board Certification is a rigorous professional assessment process that leads to a nationally recognized professional teaching credential (National Board Certified Teacher or NBCT).
- "National Board Certification was designed to develop, retain and recognize accomplished teachers and to generate ongoing improvement in schools nationwide. It's the highest certification a teacher may obtain in addition to being the most respected one." (www.nbpts.org/certification)

CERTIFICATION PROCESS

- Teachers take an assessment and create a portfolio documenting the following:
 - Content knowledge evidenced through an online assessment
 - Differentiation in instruction evidenced through samples of student work
 - Documentation and reflection of the learning environment with videos and written reflection
 - Formative & summative assessment analysis evidenced through student work

History of HCPS National Board Support Network

HCPS has been supporting National Board candidates for over 21 years

- Began 2001 with monthly meetings run by volunteers in the basement of BAHS
- Primarily consisted of reading entries and providing logistical support

Support network became the responsibility of the PD Office

• A Teacher Specialist developed support curriculum and resource page was developed

Support transitioned to NBCTs (Classroom Teachers) with support from the PD Office

- Curriculum continued with monthly meetings staffed by 3-4 full-time teachers
- Readers were all on a volunteer basis

MD Blueprint and MD Leads Grant funding for NBC support

- Increased HCPS candidates from approximately 25 to almost 200
- Continues with 3 full-time teacher lead facilitators, adding facilitators & readers
- Monthly in-person support sessions
- Synchronous/asynchronous online support course

Set high, worthwhile goals appropriate for these students, at this time, in this setting


4th

Evaluate student learning in light of the goals and the instruction.

6th

Set new high and worthwhile goals that are appropriate for these students at this time.

Your Students – Who are they?
Where are they now? What do they need and in what order do they need it? Where should I begin?



3rd

Implement instruction designed to attain those goals.

5th

Reflect on student learning, the effectiveness of the instructional design, particular concerns, and issues.



Research Supporting National Board Certification



Students of NBCTs gain
1 to 2 months of learning compared to peers in other classrooms



Students of
NBCTs
demonstrate
evidence of
deeper learning
nearly 3 times
more frequently
than their peers



NBCTs were significantly more effective than non-NBCT peers in high school end-of-course classes

Certification Process

Initial: \$1900*

Maintenance: \$495*

*Candidates pay a non-refundable \$75 registration fee per year

Achieved Certification

- Salary increase of \$10,000 annually
- Additional \$7,000 annually for Low-Performing Schools
