Board of Education of Harford County Informational Report Presentation on HCPS Academic Performance 2022-2023 September 11, 2023

Background Information:

The purpose of this presentation is to provide an update regarding academic measures for Harford County Public Schools (HCPS) from the 2022-2023 school year. This presentation includes student performance data from state assessments in the areas of English/Language Arts Literacy, mathematics, science, and social studies. Goal 1 of the Strategic Plan indicates that HCPS prepares every student for success in postsecondary education and a career. Several metrics from Goal 1 will be shared, including proficiency rates on the Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) in the core content areas. The data will show a historical trend of HCPS performance as well as a comparison to select counties within Maryland. In addition, the principals of two schools who demonstrated a high level of growth will share their best practices for improving student achievement.

- MCAP English/Language Arts historical proficiency rates and a comparison to other districts
- MCAP mathematics historical proficiency rates and a comparison to other districts
- Maryland Integrated Science Assessment (MISA) historical proficiency rates
- American Government historical proficiency rates
