<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This procurement is being requested to provide services in connection with the US Department of Education’s 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers (CCLC) Grant.</li> <li>• Harford County Public Schools has been awarded \$5,475,000.00 over three (3) years to provide youth development programs at five (5) schools, including Aberdeen Middle, Edgewood Elementary, Edgewood Middle, Magnolia Elementary, and Magnolia Middle.</li> <li>• The awarded grant proposal lists The Y In Central Maryland as a community partner for school years including 2023-2024, 2024-2025, and 2025-2026.</li> <li>• Following the initial award, subsequent award years will be contingent upon availability of funding from the specific funding authority, satisfactory performance by the grantee as evaluated by MSDE, compliance with all grant requirements, and meeting all conditions set forth within the 21st CCLC proposal.</li> <li>• The Y in Central Maryland will partner with HCPS working collaboratively with the HCPS Project Director and Site Coordinators, providing supervision, support, curriculum materials, staff training, and data in relation to the after-school program under the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers Grant.</li> <li>• In addition to participating in academic support taught by HCPS teachers, The Y In Central Maryland will provide enrichment programs which include presentations, field trips, youth leadership experience, robotics, and Lego leagues.</li> <li>• The program will be offered Monday through Thursday after school between the hours of 3:00 PM – 6:00 PM in middle schools and 3:45 PM – 6:45 PM in elementary schools.</li> </ul>
