**Presentation on Maryland Report Card Framework 2022-2023**  
**December 18, 2023**

**Background Information:**

The purpose of this presentation is to provide an update regarding the release of the Maryland Report Card results for Harford County Public Schools (HCPS) from the 2022-2023 school year. This presentation includes the academic and non-academic measures that comprise the framework. Goal 1 of the Strategic Plan indicates that HCPS prepares every student for success in postsecondary education and a career. Several metrics from Goal 1 will be shared, including proficiency rates on the Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) in the core content areas, student progress with MCAP, chronic absenteeism, and graduation rates. The data will show a two-year trend of HCPS performance as well as a comparison to select counties within Maryland. In addition, the principal of Roye-Williams Elementary School will share the successes and challenges of chronic absenteeism.

**Discussion:**

The following measures will be presented:

- Academic achievement based on MCAP results for English/Language Arts Literacy and mathematics
- Academic progress results based on MCAP
- English Language proficiency results based on the W-ACCESS assessment
- High school graduation rates
- Readiness for postsecondary success
- Chronic Absenteeism rates
- Climate survey results for educators and students
- Access to a well-rounded curriculum
