PRESENTATION OF FY 2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

July 15, 2024

Background Information:

The <u>Rules</u>, <u>Regulations</u>, and <u>Procedures for the Administration of the Public School Construction Program</u> require each local education agency (LEA) to submit annually its school system's Capital Improvement Program (CIP) to the state and local governments.

Discussion:

This is the first presentation of the FY 2026 CIP. This presentation is meant to assist the Board of Education in understanding the current CIP funding process and requirements.

This presentation will focus on the State eligible capital projects. In September, we will ask the Board of Education to approve the FY 2026 State CIP request for submission to the Interagency Commission, the State funding authority for public school construction projects.

Between now and January, we will continue to work with the Board of Education and stakeholders to prioritize the FY 2026 local only CIP needs and align the request with our operating budget. In December, we will ask the Board of Education to approve the FY 2026 CIP for submission to the local government.

Superintendent's Recommendation:

The Superintendent of Schools recommends that the Board of Education accept this informational report and presentation of the FY 2026 Capital Improvement Program.


