Background Information:

The Board handbook advises members of the Board of Education of Harford County of the requirements and responsibilities of their office. The handbook sets forth and describes the most significant responsibilities and requirements of Board membership and the provisions of law and regulation, Board policy and protocols which govern the performance and actions of Board members as they carry out the duties of their office. To this extent the handbook sets forth specific rules of procedure not otherwise set forth in law, regulation or Board policy, such specific rules are binding upon the Board.

The handbook does not contain an exhaustive list of all the requirements and responsibilities of Board membership. Rather, the handbook is intended to serve as an overview of the most important regulations and responsibilities of Board membership.

The Board handbook was adopted on December 20, 2010, and last amended and adopted on May 8, 2017.
