#### **Background Information:**

The <u>Rules, Regulations, and Procedures for the Administration of the Public School Construction Program</u> require each local education agency (LEA) to submit annually its school system's Capital Improvement Program (CIP) to the state and local governments.

#### Discussion:

This is the second presentation of the FY 2025 CIP. The State funding authority for public school construction projects, known as the Interagency Commission (IAC), requires LEAs to submit CIP requests by October 4, 2024. This presentation will focus on the State eligible priorities for the Harford County Public Schools FY 2026 CIP request. The table below summarizes the priorities eligible for State funding, potential funding source, and request amounts.
