Dr. Carpenter provided the following updates:

- 1. GT identification updates: CoGAT has been administered across the county in grade 2.Our identification process continues to be built for this year and will include three universal screening methods: Ability: CoGAT, Academic: SRI/enVision 2.0 benchmarks, Teacher Input: Primary Talent Development (PTD).
- 2. State COMAR Updates: MSDE has the revised CoMAR regulations out for public comment. Shared the highlights of the regulations. Click <u>HERE</u> to see and read and provide public comment.
- 3. Equity in Identification (Peters' work): Dr. Carpenter shared Peters' work around equity in identification and shared that he would be working with central office personnel to determine the next steps with identification.
- 4. Advocacy: Yvonne encouraged people to participate in public comment and provide written feedback to the changes in CoMAR for GT. She also advised speaking to the State Board at the meeting on February 26, 2019.
- 5. GT Discover: Dr. Carpenter shared that a new website called, "GT Discover" will be unveiled. The website is a product of a Javits Grant and will provide the community with access to resources, research and materials. Once released, Dr. Carpenter will share through the proper school channels.

6. Accelerated Learning Handbook is further along in production. Dr. Carpenter hopes to bring it to the General Curriculum Committee in February.
