Harford County Public Schools begins 2011-12 school year with two new key leadership members in place

The two newest additions to the Harford County Public Schools (HCPS) leadership team just kicked off a new school year for the first time in their current capacities. Joseph A. Schmitz, a nearly 20-year veteran of
