HCPS Earns Two National Recognitions

Financial Reporting and Distinguished Budget Presentation awards presented to HCPS

The Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) recently announced that Harford County Public Schools (HCPS) is the recipient of two national recognitions. The Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting was received for the HCPS comprehensive annual financial report (CAFR) for fiscal year 2015. The Distinguished Budget Presentation Award was also received for the annual budget for fiscal year 2016, beginning July 1, 2015.

The Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting, and its attainment represents a significant accomplishment by HCPS. The CAFR was judged by an impartial panel to meet the high standards of the program, including demonstrating a constructive "spirit of full disclosure" to clearly communicate its financial story and encourage readership. This is the 12th consecutive year that HCPS has received this award.

The Distinguished Budget Presentation Award is the only national awards program in governmental budgeting. In order to receive the budget award, HCPS had to publish a budget document that satisfies program criteria as a policy document, as an operations guide, as a financial plan, and as a communications device. Budget documents must be rated "proficient" in all four categories, and the 14 mandatory criteria within those categories, to receive the award. The award reflects the commitment of the governing body and staff to meeting the highest principles of governmental budgeting. This is the 14th consecutive year that HCPS has received this award.
