### Program Description

The Extended School Year (ESY) program assists students with disabilities in maintaining the skills at risk of regression and attain the critical life skills or self-sufficiency goals essential to continued progress and development.

The Extended School Year (ESY) Elementary Program provides a continuum of special education and related services to students in grades Kindergarten – 5<sup>th</sup> grade, including students accessing a Least Restrictive Environment through one of HCPS regional programs. Staff will support the planning and implementation of student Individualized Education Programs (IEPS) June 24<sup>th</sup> – August 1<sup>st</sup>.
