

## **Elementary Summer Learning Program Support Services Program Information**

### **Program Description**

The Harford County Public Schools (HCPS) Elementary Summer Learning Program provides expanded access to curricula aligned to the Maryland State Curriculum through the delivery of high-quality instruction. Support staff will be hired to support teachers and students in a face-to-face setting at one of the five regional program sites. The curriculum will be focused on supporting both reading and math instruction. The reading instruction will be designed using the 2021 Lucy Calkins Units of Study summer school curriculum. Math will be a combination of online intervention and instructional units provided by the math curriculum office.
