

Harford County Infants and Toddlers Program Summer Services Information Sheet

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Harford County Infants and Toddlers Program (HCITP) is an early intervention program for children birth to 4 years of age and their families. Through family-centered services and coaching practices, parents and caregivers are provided guidance and support to help their child be successful at home and in the community as well as develop school readiness skills.

PROGRAM SCHEDULE

The HCITP is a 12-month service. Summer services will be provided during the period of June (immediately following the last duty day for teachers) to August 25, 2025.

PROGRAM LOCATION

Services are provided in the “natural environment” which can include locations such as home, day care, preschool, camp, and/or other community settings. Applicants must have a reliable means of transportation.

Applicants hired to provide summer services for the HCITP will have the ability to work full or part-time; days and hours will be worked out directly with the program coordinator.
