### **ADMISSION CRITERIA**

Scholars may apply to a total of three Magnet Programs. For Harford Tech, choose only one program

Applicants will receive further communication from each Program Specialist, as appropriate, to indicate offer/acceptance status.

- 1. Academic achievement and performance in middle school
  - Grades
  - Standardized test scores



- Teacher endorsements
- School and community involvement (Activity List)
- Responses to open-ended questions

- International Baccalaureate at Edgewood
- Science and Math Academy at Aberdeen
- Certified Nursing Assistant at Harford Technical
- Computer Aided Design and Drafting at Harford Technical

- IT Networking Academy at Harford Technical

If I need guidance accessing the application, who can I ask?

Can I apply to more than one program?

- Yes. You may apply for up to 3 programs.




- How can I improve my chances of being accepted into a Magnet program?
  - Ensure your application is complete, your responses are complete and well-written, and you put forth your best effort in middle school.
- I receive accomodations through an IEP or 504 Plan. Am I eligible?
  - Yes, and services will continue as described in your plan.
- I am currently on Home/Hospital Teaching. Am I eligible?
   Yes.
- How will I find out about transportation?

   Please visit <u>HCPS Transportation</u> for the most current information.

  - Magnet Programs are a 4-year commitment. Students are not permitted to move between programs, but may elect to withdraw from the Magnet and return to their community schools.
- If a Magnet is offered at two or more sites, can I choose the location?
   No, you are applying to a program, not a school. For programs offered in multiple locations, seats are assigned at random.
- What are my options if I am not accepted into a Magent?
   You may enroll in any of the CTE programs offered in your neighborhood school, including Apprenticeship and Workforce Investment programs.

HCPS Students: Your information will autofill. Verify it is correct or make edits.


Non-HCPS Students: Carefully and accurately enter all information to create your profile.

- You can access your application until 11:59 pm on December 3rd.
- Within your account, you can withdraw your application if you change your mind.
- Contact your School Counselor for assistance.

# APPLICATION continued

You can <u>SAVE</u> your application and work on it over time.

But remember to return to and <u>SUBMIT</u> it before the deadline.



- TEACHER ENDORSEMENTS

  HCPS students: Your teachers will autopopulate the application.

  Non-HCPS students: Accurately enter teacher contact information.

  The teacher endorsement is valid for all Programs to which you apply.
- Submit a bulleted ACTIVITY LIST by December 3rd.
   This list only needs to be submitted once and is active for all programs to which you apply.
  - Once you SUBMIT an Activity List, you cannot make changes to it.
- Each Magnet you select will ask you to respond to open-ended prompts.
  - All responses must be submitted by December 3rd.
  - Changes to these responses cannot be made after submitting.
- Click "Submit Application." You may then return to the Home Page to apply to another program.


