Graduation Requirements

Requirements for graduation from a Maryland Public High School are listed below. Students must earn a minimum of 26 credits in Grades 9 through 12 to receive a Maryland High School Diploma from Harford County Public Schools.

Subject Area	Specific Credit Requirements
English	4 Credits
Mathematics	4 credits, including Algebra and Geometry. Must be enrolled in a mathematics course in each year of high school (maximum of 4 years of attendance, unless in the 5th or 6th year a mathematics course is needed to meet a graduation requirement)
Science	3 Credits including Biology
Social Studies	3 Credits including US History, US (American) Government, and World History
Fine Art	1 Credit
Phys Ed	1 Credit including Foundations of Fitness and Physical Activity
Health	1 Credit
Technology	1 Credit of Foundations of Technology or AP Computer Science Principles
Career Pathway and Completer Program Requirements	4-6 Credits 4 credits in an approved Career & Technology Education (CTE) Career Completer Program Or 2 World Language + University Systems of Maryland (USM) requirements--(4 years of math including Algebra II or beyond in the senior year).
Electives	May vary according to program

**** It is the expectation that if you are enrolled in an AP course, you will take the AP exam at the end of the school year. Requests to drop an AP course will only be considered at the end of 1st quarter with Administrator approval.
