

2022 Middle School Summer School Program Description

Dates: July 11, 2022- August 4, 2022

All buildings will be closed on July 19, 2022, for Election Day

Times: 7:45 AM- 11:00 AM

Regional Sites: Edgewood Middle School, Havre de Grace Middle School, and North Harford Middle School

The 2022 Middle School Summer Program will provide students with in-person learning to revisit grade level skills. The Middle School Summer Program is designed for students who struggled to meet course requirements during the 2021-2022 school year. The focus will be on mathematics and reading instruction aligned to the State Standards. Additionally, students will engage in activities to support their social emotional wellbeing as well as participate in movement breaks. This program is tuition-free, no payment will be required.

If transportation becomes available, it will be provided to those students who choose to attend a site in their home school's region (see chart below). Parents/guardians of registered students will be contacted prior to the start of the program if transportation becomes available.
