DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE	<ul> <li>These items are intended only as examples of the various types of job duties to be performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is a similar, related, or logical assignment to the position.</li> <li>Performs all of the essential functions of the Plumbing and Heating I position with a high degree of skill.</li> <li>Assists the Plant Chief and Crew Chief in the direction and assignment of work orders.</li> <li>Installs and maintains water fountains, coolers, toilets, lavatories, urinals, showers, and other fixtures and appliances involving plumbing.</li> <li>Diagnoses and repairs problems related to domestic H2O wells, all associated equipment, and to sewage treatment systems.</li> <li>Services oil and gas-fired burners and related controls.</li> <li>Assembles and installs cast iron boilers and water storage tanks.</li> <li>Installs and maintains all types of control systems.</li> <li>Responds and assists during emergency situations including, but not limited to, inclement weather assignments, vandalism, and emergency repairs.</li> </ul>

REQUIREMENTS	<ul> <li>High school diploma or GED; plumbing license preferred.</li> <li>Five years experience in the trade.</li> <li>Hold a valid driver's license and willing to obtain and maintain a valid commercial driver's license.</li> <li>Able to read and interpret drawings, list and calculate quantities of materials needed, layout and measure material to specifications, and list tools and materials used.</li> <li>Able to direct the work of others.</li> <li>Possess thorough knowledge and skill in the use of hand and power tools, safety procedures, and maintenance techniques associated with the plumbing and heating trade.</li> <li>Physically able to perform the essential functions, with or without reasonable accommodations, of the everyday responsibilities including lifting materials weighing up to 50 pounds and the ability to climb ladders in excess of 15 feet. Various lifts, tools and mechanical means of assistance should be employed for lifting heavier supplies, equipment and material.</li> <li>Able to follow plans, determine sequence of operations, and complete a project using acceptable procedures.</li> <li>Willing to pursue any special licenses related to the plumbing and heating trade.</li> <li>Must be available to respond to emergency calls, including after hour emergencies.</li> </ul>
