Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Must have a permanent address and reside in one of the following states/districts: California, Colorado, Georgia, Hawaii, Maryland, Oregon, Virginia, Washington, or Washington D.C.
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent), earned from 9th grade through the first semester/term of 12th grade
- Must plan to enroll full-time in an accredited, public or not-for-profit, four-year university, or community college, in the US, for the 2022-2023 academic year

Other

- Students must have a demonstrated interest in pursuing a clinical (e.g., pharmacist, physician, practitioner, nurse) or non-clinical (e.g., accounting, business administration, finance, human resources, marketing, operations public policy) career in the healthcare industry
- Preference will be given to students with demonstrated financial need
- Preference will be given to students from underrepresented communities



Timeline

Online applications opened January 1, 2022, and close March 1, 2022, 5:00 PM PT. Scholarship recipients will be selected in June 2022, with awards disbursed in the fall (October-December).
