RIDER MUST BE:

- A Harford County resident
- At least 8 years old by the start of camp and have a disability
- Able to walk without an assistive device and sidestep to both sides
- Able to attend all sessions during the 5-day camp
- Under 220 lbs. and have a minimum inseam measurement of 20” (*measured from floor with sneakers on*)
- Willing and able to wear a properly fitted bike helmet
