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This Addendum is issued in response to prospective bidder's inquiries and to add/clarify verbiage in the Bid.

1. **DELETE:** Page Header "22-JHS-018 Paving and ADA Improvements at Various Locations".

**ADD:** Page Header "25-JHM-008 Disposal Services – Science Chemicals and Chemical Waste".

2. **QUESTION:** Are we required to price all specialty items, or can we choose not to bid items that outside of our normal scope?

**ANSWER:** No, this section is only if you can provide us with pricing.

3. **QUESTION:** Please provide reports, manifests, and/or invoices to help determine the quantities generated for each line item in the previous year.

**ANSWER:** See attached.

4. **QUESTION:** We have an established contract with Baltimore County Public Schools. Is HCPS willing to piggyback off of the BCPS contract? Calvert County, Carroll County, and Howard County also ride off this contract.

**ANSWER:** HCPS has decided to do their own solicitation.

5. **QUESTION:** Can you confirm if prevailing wage applies to this contract? If so, does it apply to all locations? Is it strictly for onsite activities?

**ANSWER:** Prevailing wages do not apply.

6. **QUESTION:** Can you clarify the expectations around MBE contributions as they relate to this contract? The document mentions "attachment 1a" but it does not appear to be included; is this required?

**ANSWER:** MBE is not a requirement.

7. **QUESTION:** Is the contract value determined by the first year or the potential total of the option years?

**ANSWER:** Refer to Specifications, Section 2.4, Scope of Work, page 28. This contract is an indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity contract. The amount listed in this section is an approximate amount annually.

8. **QUESTION:** What does “work completed after pickup” in Group #1:Hourly Labor Rates relate to?

**ANSWER:** Work completed after pickup refers to any additional work that is completed outside the scope of Item 1 under Group #1.

9. **QUESTION:** Are all lines meant to represent pricing the same for both lab packs (i.e. inner containers) and non-lab pack material (i.e. drums of liquids/solids)?

**ANSWER:** Non-Hazardous items have their own group pricing. See Group #10.

10. **QUESTION:** Are we to assume that a supply is needed for all lines we are pricing or how do we differentiate those materials that will not need one?

**ANSWER:** Items 1-41 require pricing; specialty items are optional.

11. **QUESTION:** Are we required to adhere to the specific treatment options listed in each section or can alternatives be considered if they follow the preferences to avoid landfill? If so, how would you like us to present those treatments.

**ANSWER:** As long as Federal, State, and Local guidelines are followed, disposal or treatment choices are up to the Awarded Bidder if they follow the preference to avoid landfills.

12. **QUESTION:** Can you provide the waste profiles for the locations that currently have them?

**ANSWER:** All EPA IDs are located on their website and can be searched for accordingly. <https://rcrapublic.epa.gov/rcrainfoweb/action/modules/hd/handlerindex>.

13. **QUESTION:** Can you provide the waste shipment data for 2023 so we can better understand the shipment sizes, frequencies, etc.?

**ANSWER:** Refer to Question #3 of this Addendum.

14. **QUESTION:** Who is responsible for arranging the waste shipments and grouping the schools?

**ANSWER:** This falls to the Awarded Bidder. HCPS will submit requests and coordinate access to buildings and locations, but scheduling the lab pack/transport is on the Awarded Bidder.

15. **QUESTION:** Is there any minimum number of schools or volume of material that will be included per occurrence?

**ANSWER:** No, but we try to have multiple locations awaiting disposal before submitting a request.

16. **QUESTION:** Do all locations listed dispose of material annually?

**ANSWER:** No.

17. **QUESTION:** Please confirm if this contract requires Certified Payroll or Prevailing Wage Rates.
- ANSWER:** Certified Payroll or Prevailing Wage Rates do not apply.
18. **QUESTION:** Is a Certificate of Disposal (COD) required for payment?
- ANSWER:** It is not required for payment, but it is still a necessary document to be supplied to HCPS.
19. **QUESTION:** Please confirm if Item 1 is billed portal to portal or on-site time only.
- ANSWER:** Refer to Specifications, Section 5.1, Hourly Rates, page 35.
20. **QUESTION:** Please provide examples of previously shipped temperature sensitive materials.
- ANSWER:** HCPS had not had any temperature sensitive materials disposed of within the last 5 years. This is an optional category.
21. **QUESTION:** Please provide examples of previously shipped radioactive materials.
- ANSWER:** HCPS has not had any radioactive materials disposed of within the last 5 years. This is an optional category.
22. **QUESTION:** If wastewater treatment is not a service offered, would HCPS accept landfill as an alternative?
- ANSWER:** Wastewater treatment and disposal is not included in this contract. Only disposal of chemicals used for wastewater treatment is included.
23. **QUESTION:** Would HCPS allow a bid with a fixed CPI escalation annual?
- ANSWER:** Refer to Specifications, Section 10, Pricing and Rate Adjustments, page 37.
24. **QUESTION:** Who is the current vendor / incumbent?
- ANSWER:** Republic Services.
25. **QUESTION:** Can we have the current contract copy.
- ANSWER:** See attached.
26. **QUESTION:** What is the Annual spent / last 3 invoices ?
- ANSWER:** See attached.
27. **QUESTION:** What is the budgetary number for the waste removal and disposal service in 2024?
- ANSWER:** Refer to Question #7 of this Addendum.
28. **QUESTION:** Does vendor need any special equipment to make these pickups, any limitations of the loading area?
- ANSWER:** Vendor will need to provide any material handling equipment to include ramps or lifts to ingress their transport vehicles as many schools will not have a loading dock available.

29. **QUESTION:** Can we please receive the manifests from some of the past shipments? Specifically, can we receive the manifests for all shipment from 2022, 2023 and 2024?

**ANSWER:** Refer to Question #3 of this Addendum.

30. **QUESTION:** Can you elaborate on an “average” type of or size of a routine pick up?

**ANSWER:** “Average” is not fully quantifiable. A typical disposal day will consist of 3-5 locations depending on the location of each location and the quantity amassed. Refer to the attached invoices for approximation of quantities.

31. **QUESTION:** Will this be a single award? Or will multiple vendors be selected? Is this a multiple vendor award?

**ANSWER:** Refer to Specifications, Section 8, Award, page 37.

32. **QUESTION:** If a request is made to pick up and lab pack waste, how long do we have to schedule and execute that pick up?

**ANSWER:** The timeline for scheduling and pick-up should be determined between the vendor scheduler and HCPS coordinator within a week of HCPS submitting a request for disposal.

33. **QUESTION:** Please provide current contract rates for this opportunity.

**ANSWER:** See attached.

34. **QUESTION:** The bid includes “construction contract” terms. Please verify this is the correct contract. ( It references a Paving improvement bid in header)

**ANSWER:** Refer to #1 of this Addendum.

35. **QUESTION:** Is there a minority business goal for this work?

**ANSWER:** Refer to Question #6 of this Addendum.

36. **QUESTION:** Do wastes need to be weighed onsite during packaging or can vendor provide gross weight of containers packaged.

**ANSWER:** Waste does not need to be weighed on site.

37. **QUESTION:** Please indicate which waste streams are bulk vs labpack on the bid sheet?

**ANSWER:** To be determined at the time of disposal request. Some groups may have both bulk and labpacks depending on the need of each location.

38. **QUESTION:** There are potentially explosive line items on bid form however there is no labor category for high haz personnel. Can this be added to bid form?

**ANSWER:** No, these items are considered Specialty Items and will not affect the basis of the contract award. The pricing information requested is for informational purposes only. Bidders may attach price lists that include all costs associated with these items.

39. **QUESTION:** Please provide additional information for radioactive waste item on bid sheet

**ANSWER:** Refer to #21 of this Addendum.
