4. A copy of an acceptance letter from a four-year college or university
5. Must have demonstrated a high level of academic excellence.
6. An official sealed high school transcript
7. A senior portrait or appropriate photo for publication
8. A **completed** Iota Nu Scholarship Application Form

Community Service:

1. Graduating senior.
2. GPA 2.5 or above
3. Two Letters of recommendation:
 - a. One from a teacher
 - b. One from a member of the community
4. A copy of an acceptance letter from a four-year college or university
5. Must have demonstrated merit in the community service /volunteerism
6. An official sealed high school transcript
7. A senior portrait or appropriate photo for publication
8. A **completed** Iota Nu Scholarship Application Form

Perseverance:

1. Graduating senior.
2. GPA 2.0 or above
3. Two Letters of recommendation:
 - a. One from a teacher
 - b. One from a member of the community
4. A copy of an acceptance letter from a four-year college or university
5. Must have demonstrated overcoming hardship/adversity.
6. An official sealed high school transcript
7. A senior portrait or appropriate photo for publication
8. A **completed** Iota Nu Scholarship Application Form

Applicants may apply to each category; however, only one scholarship can be awarded per applicant. An application form can be obtained from your high school guidance counselor, www.ques-iotanu.org, or from the undersigned. All information must be postmarked by **April 24, 2026**, and mailed to the Iota Nu Chapter, P.O. Box 373, APG, MD 21005. Applications that are electronically emailed will not be processed. College students are not eligible to apply. Application materials must be submitted in one packet. Do not send transcripts and letters of recommendation under separate cover letters. SAT / ACT scores must be included on the application at the time it is mailed. **Incomplete, e-mailed, or faxed** applications will not be considered.
