The Engineering Society of Baltimore is offering merit-based scholarships and academic loans to graduating high school students pursuing a degree in engineering in an ABET accredited program. The scholarships and academic loans are limited to students from the Baltimore Metropolitan area including Baltimore City and Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, Harford and Howard Counties. Multiple scholarships will be awarded, including the following:

- A \$3,500 James Posey Associates Centennial Scholarship (preferably awarded to a student enrolled in a mechanical or electrical engineering program).
- The following scholarship opportunities are also anticipated:
  - The American Society of Highway Engineers (ASHE) may be offering two scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 each to be awarded to individuals aspiring to a career in the Highway Industry (including, but not limited to Civil and Environmental Engineering, Water Resources, Traffic Engineering, Transportation Planning and Construction Management).
  - The American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) may be offering a scholarship in the amount of \$2,500 to be awarded to individuals aspiring to a career in Civil Engineering.
  - The Maryland Hispanic Chamber of Commerce may be offering up to two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each for candidates with Hispanic Heritage.
  - The Engineers Week Council will offer several awards to outstanding candidates.
  - Additional scholarship awards will be made to outstanding candidates based on specific criteria defined by additional scholarship sponsors.

- The application will be available starting January 5, 2026.
- The deadline for application is 11:59 PM, Friday, March 22, 2026.
